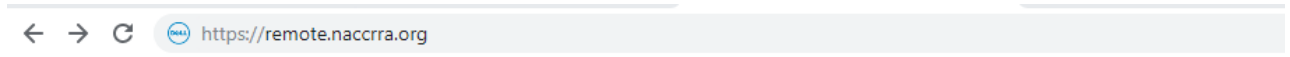




How-To: VPN



2. Open and the NetExtender app on your computer.
 - a. Note: after the first time connecting, the following info will save in the drop-down list.
 - b. Enter "remote.naccrra.org:4433" in the Server field
 - c. Enter your username in "first.last" format.
 - d. Enter your Windows/Email password.
 - e. Enter "NACCRRRA" in the domain field.

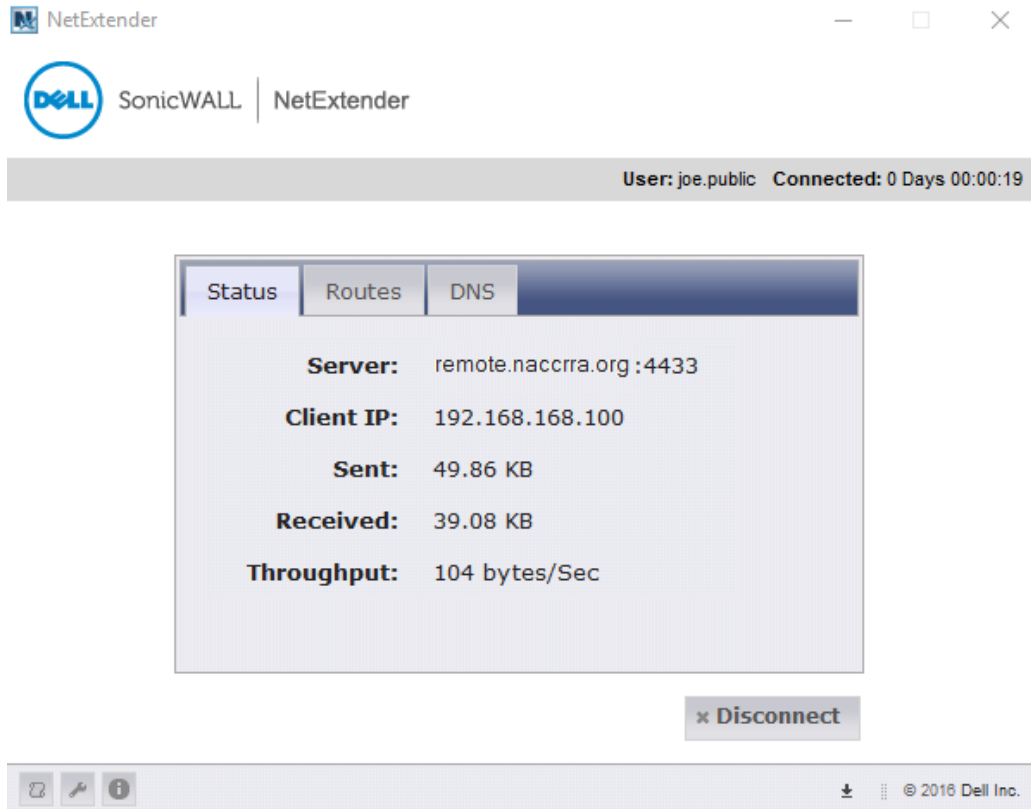
